



Tripping the Light Translucent

This will give you some really innovative translucent techniques in Polymer clay and help you with a basic understanding of how to make the effects pop more in the future pieces you will want to make. These fun and almost magical techniques challenge the thought process of the expert and motivate the beginning student with ease of execution.



Spend the day with Marie working in Cernit. She will help you get to know this wonderful polymer clay, how to take care of it, how to store it, conditioning hacks, and featuring the natural abilities to your advantage. Because of the depth and clarity of the Cernit, Marie finds this the best clay to work with. She will talk about using it with other polymer clays to feature and enhance their best assets.

Supply List

1. sheets of the metal leaf you like.
2. sharp new tissue blade.
3. deli wrap- plastic sheets
4. stamps rubber- red and gray is best
5. Stazon ink pad-black
6. pasta machine (**NO MOTORS**)
7. small roller - acrylic or stainless
8. gloves for inks
9. small ruler
10. work surface
11. favorite tools you use for caning, needle tools, skewers, etc...



This is what Marie will supply to you! (covered with the \$20 materials fee)

Cernit clay: 1 500 gram package of translucent, 6 translucent colors, 3 opaque white and 2 black
She will also provide some foils, glitter, gold or silver leaf sheets and more.

“Trina’s Way” Program

“Trina’s Way” was established in memory of Trina Kern, a longtime guild member and past president of MDPAG. Trina’s passion for polymer clay was apparent as she attended every workshop offered by MDPAG. Although Trina passed away in 2003, she will always be remembered for her generosity and kindness.

Marie Johannes, founder of MDPAG, proposed establishing a program in Trina’s honor. In 2003 Marie donated items from her polymer clay art collection to the retreat Silent Auction. Proceeds from the sale of these items established the “Trina’s Way” fund. The guild has continued to donate auction proceeds to fund the “Trina’s Way” program which is typically held every other year or when funds become available. “Trina’s Way” classes are free to every guild member in good standing at the time of registration.

A talented guest artist is selected each year that the “Trina’s Way” class is held. Typically, two days of classes will be held to accommodate as many members as possible with the funds collected. Each class teaches the same technique and has a maximum class size. Once the class is filled names will be put on a wait list. Early registration is important to guarantee a spot in the class. Forms will be accepted by mail in order by postmark date.

“Trina’s Way” Class Requirements

The "Trina's Way" program was established with the following requirements for all students as a way for MDPAG to give to the community. If any of the class requirements are not fulfilled or you do not attend the class, your deposit check will be cashed. Your check will be shredded if you fulfill the following requirements.

Create 5 bottles for the "Bottles of Hope". **These must be turned in before the class.**

These bottles can be created using any style or technique. Please bring them in a bag labeled with your name. They will be donated in Trina Kern's name to Gilda’s Club of Metro Detroit.

Create 5 bottles for the "Bottles of Hope" and **turn them in by the September meeting.**

These need to be created using the techniques that the guest artist teaches in the class. Please bring them in a bag labeled with your name. Bottles will be turned in to Kathie Harroun (Outreach coordinator). They will be donated in Trina Kern's name to Gilda’s Club of Metro Detroit. They may also be mailed to Kathie Harroun at 3309 Signet Dr., Waterford, Michigan 48329
